What is your elevator speech? If you had someone's attention for 60 seconds and you wanted to tell them the message for your organization, what would it be? What is your elevator speech for why someone should go to an ACA camp? ACA National President, Peter Surgenor shared his elevator speech with a gathering of all the section presidents in a Field Service Meeting in Chicago. He said that there are three reasons why ACA does camp better than anyone else: 1) Camps help make better human connections. Friends are made. There is even a TV ad running by a health insurance company that asks parents to model good eating habits with their kids. Peter's elevator speech has never been more important. As the economy is on a rocky road, our message to the public needs to be strong, because camp should not be seen to the public as a luxury. Camp needs to be understood that it is a part of a person's human development..

Last December, an Indiana ice storm keep ACA's National CEO, Peg Smith away from our annual meeting, I have been assured by the local weather forecasters that can't happen twice in a row. 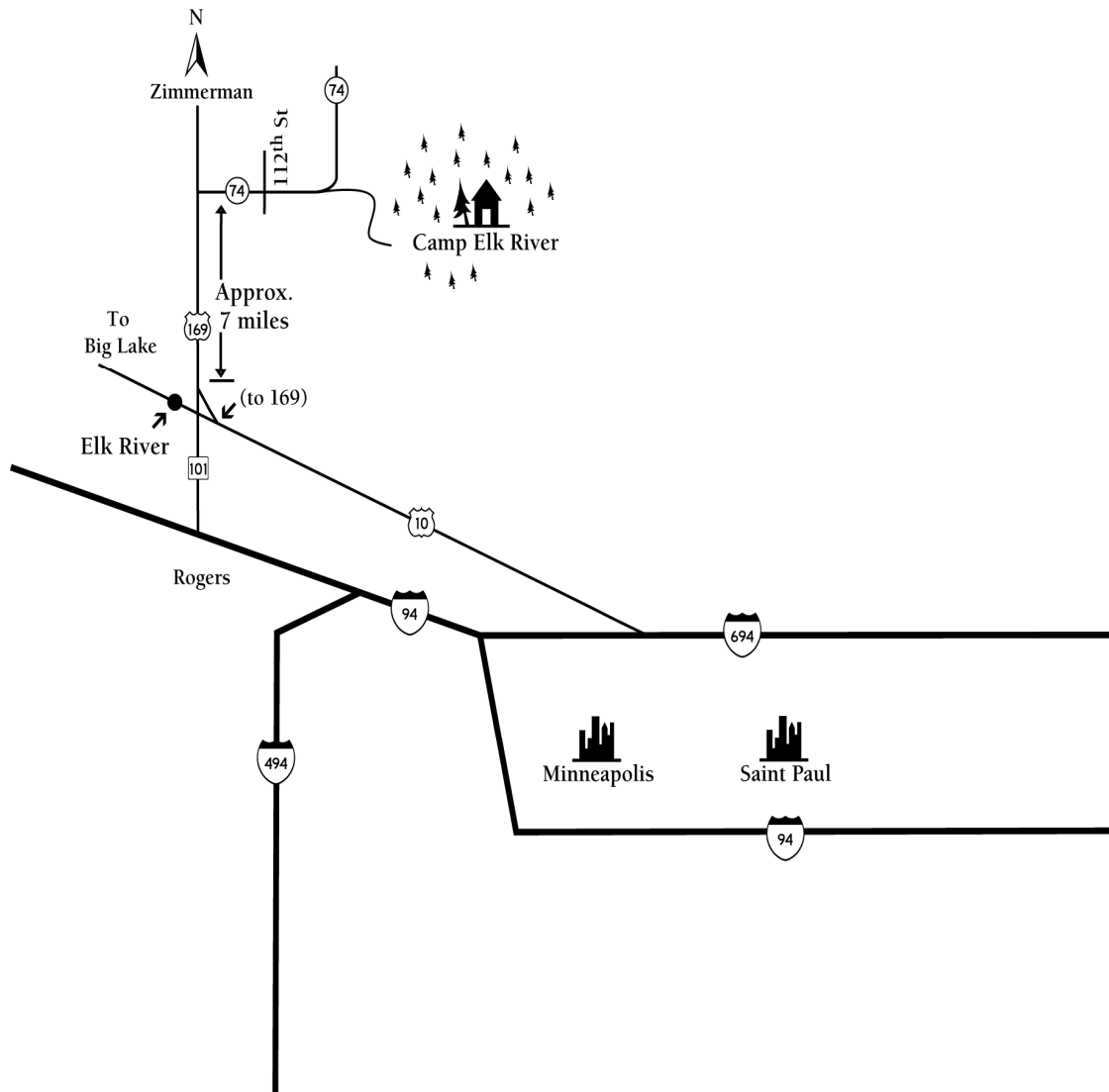

Travel west on I-94 to Rogers, exit Highway 101. Go north on 101 to Elk River, where 101 forms US 169. Continue north on US 169 to Sherburne County Road 74. Turn right on County Road 74 (237th Avenue) and go about 1 mile to gravel road. (County Road 74 continues onto the left.) Continue on the gravel road past the site manager's home on the right. The road will curve to the right. Then turn right at the Lake Barbara sign. Continue straight ahead to the Gray Koch Program building. The parking lot is on the right.
