Why a Congressional Camp Caucus?

Each year, more than 26 million children attend day and overnight camps across the United States. Camps play a vital role in youth development, education, and workforce preparation—while also supporting families, rural economies, and international cultural exchange.

The Congressional Camp Caucus will provide a bipartisan forum for Members of Congress to:

- Prioritize child safety by strengthening camp safety standards, supporting rigorous staff training, and ensuring secure environments for all children
- Champion access and equity in camp experiences to expand opportunities for every child
- Support rural economies and workforce development by advancing policies on rural development
- Protect and promote the camp community by safeguarding the J-1 BridgeUSA Camp Counselor Program, uplifting small businesses and nonprofits, and recognizing camps' role in building life skills, character, and youth mental health.

The American Camp Association (ACA) is the leading national organization advancing the field of camp through research, professional development, and advocacy. As part of its mission to ensure safe and high-quality camp experiences, ACA administers the only national accreditation program for camps.

- ACA Accreditation is a voluntary process, separate from state licensing, through which camps agree to comply with ACA's national standards for safety, health, and risk management
- ACA Accreditation involves an in-depth review of policies and an on-site visit by trained ACA volunteers
- ACA Accreditation provides a framework of practices that accredited camps uphold, often going beyond what state laws require
