



East Nashville- This is the closest neighborhood to Gaylord Opryland Resort. It will cost approximately \$20 (each way) in a Lyft or Uber to get to the Five Points district of East Nashville. Located there are a lot of smaller music venues (NOT country music), bars and casual restaurants:

Five Points Pizza- considered by far the best pizza in Nashville. A large pizza costs around \$25 with toppings. Seating is limited, so be prepared to wait a bit if you are in a large group (largest group that can sit together is 6 people). There is also a slice 'take out' window if you want to grab some pizza on the go!

Pharmacy Burger- Burgers and sausages with a full German beer garden outback (weather permitting). Considered one of the best burgers in Nashville. Large international beer selection.

Mas Tacos- Voted one of the top 100 taco places in the US. VERY tiny. Largest group that can sit together is about 6 people. At lunchtime the wait can be up to 1 hour. Check opening hours on their Facebook page.

For music, check out what's playing at **The Five Spot, The Basement East** and **Drifters**.

There are lots of bars in this neighborhood within walking distance.

In the Inglewood district of East Nashville is one of the best delis in Nashville voted by the Nashville Scene every year- **Mitchell's Deli**. This area is called Riverside Village. There is also a coffee shop & a pub there.

Germantown- From Gaylord Opryland a Lyft or Uber will be approximately \$22-25 each way. There are lots of restaurants and boutiques all within walking distance in this neighborhood.

For shopping- take a look at **Pieces, Bits N' Pieces, Wilder, Rich Hippies** and **Alexis & Bolt**

For eating there is **Butchertown Hall (smoked meats!), Von Elrod's** (beer garden next to the Sounds baseball stadium), **Vui's Kitchen, Mop & Broom** and **The Goat**. **The Nashville Farmers Market** is in Germantown and is open 7 days a week with lots of delicious cheap eats!

Germantown is also home to many award-winning restaurants, which are a bit higher on the \$ scale, but worth a visit for 'foodies'. Just make sure to book ahead! **Henrietta Red** (seafood & raw bar); **City House** (American); **Rolf & Daughters** (Italian); **Fifth & Taylor** (American).

Downtown- From Gaylord Opryland a Lyft or Uber will be approximately \$20 each way. This is where 'Broadway' is located. The famous street in Nashville that is home to all of our honkytonks. There is live music almost 24 hours a day. Most of the honkytonks close around 2-3am. There is no cover, so you can pop in and out of different venues to hear different bands at any time.

If you're planning on eating downtown, here are some good and affordable options: **Bakersfield Taco, The Southern, City Taproom, Martin's BBQ**.

The Country Music Hall of Fame, Bridgestone Arena (home to the Nashville Predators and concerts) and the **Ryman** (the Mother Church of Country Music) are all located here. The **Johnny Cash Museum & George Jones Museum** area also downtown and worth a visit for fans! The riverfront has recently been renovated and is a nice walk.

ACME Feed is a music & food venue located on Broadway & 1st with a rooftop bar overlooking the river. There is always great live music on the ground floor.
